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The procedure for being accepted in the Network for Higher Education in the Performing Arts:

1. Signed application sent to the Network (signed by applicant and dean)
2. Accompanied by documentation about
  - the applicants' institution and the involved persons
  - the interest in international collaboration with other similar institutions
  - Willingness to work in projects or create projects within the Network (conferences, festivals, research, etc.)
3. The Executive Board discusses the application (including a consultation of members of the Network of the region and decides about the application on a regular basis and announces the decision to the applicant.
4. If positive, the new member is free to participate in the Networks activities, projects, etc. His membership will be announced to all members.
5. If negative, the applicant is informed about the reason why, and the Executive Board may include a recommendation of what must be done to be accepted as a member of the Network.
